Sculpture must be free standing, limited to 50 lbs., and no larger than 36 inches in any direction. In regard to prints, we accept wood blocks, linoprints, and hand-pulled prints, i.e. monotypes, etc. Wrap Around Canvas will be accepted for oils and acrylics on canvas. Wrap around canvas will be accepted provided the medium covers the sides as well. No staples should be visible when the painting is hung. Unframed work must be exhibition ready and wired to hang.

ALL WORKS MUST BE ORIGINAL, FOR SALE, and NOT PREVIOUSLY SHOWN AT THE KAA GALLERY. Portraits should show price of similar work. Sale price must include frame. Pictures must be framed and ready for hanging with screw eyes, including the fold flat type, and wire. A
