This flag was built with the participation of almost 1,000 people to celebrate and honor the 250th anniversary of our United States of America. This flag is part of Muriel's ongoing series of USA art flags built to celebrate the diversity of the communities living together here in the United States of America. As an immigrant, Muriel is awed by the harmonious co-existence of Americans who celebrate their freedom in all possible ways.

Our country was created by dissension and protest against oppression and out of that the people forged superb documents and mandates that guarantee freedom and hope for all people. In the United States of America patriotism is multifaceted, multicolored and multidimensional;

Muriel's series of surprising U.S. Flags invite viewers to consider a broader look at what patriotism is now and can be in the future.
